The Lynchburg City School Board met for a budget work session at 5:03 p.m. in the Board Room at the School Administration Building. The school board received information regarding a preliminary budget for 2012-13. At this time, it is expected that the city will propose level funding for the schools. Dr. Massie explained that the Virginia Retirement System has been underfunded and in order to make up for that, increases have been passed along to localities to make up the shortfall.

The meeting recessed at 6:10 p.m.

The meeting reconvened at 6:25 p.m.

Dr. Massie presented his recommendation to request \$4,659,044 increase in local funding. This funding would support the VRS rate increase, purchase school buses, and support lost revenue due to the increase of the composite index. The balance of \$3,927,331 will be reduced by the school administration in order to balance the budget.

Upon MOTION by Mrs. Barker, SECONDED by Mr. McHenry, the school board authorized the superintendent to request from Lynchburg City Council an increase in funding of \$4,659,044 for the FY2013 school operating budget.
