\*\*Because inclement weather can happen very unexpectedly, see the different schedules for the possible scenarios.

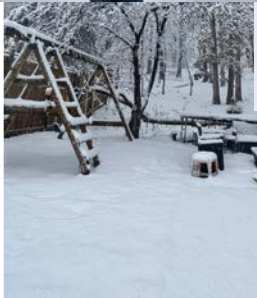

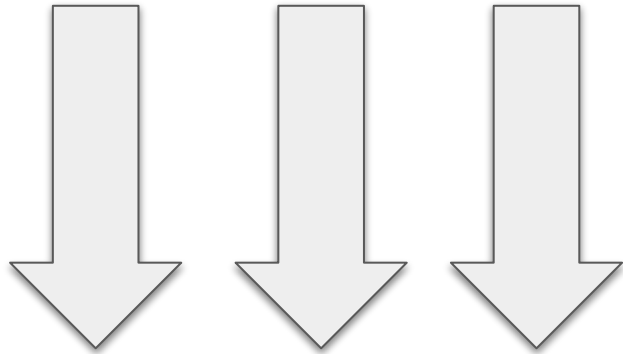
